BE PREPARED! ELECTION DAY (NOV 5) IS CLOSER THAN YOU THINK

Here are some federal, state, and county resources so you are able to perform your civic duty and exercise your right to vote if you so choose. Please note that the deadline to register to vote in the state of Florida is October 7th.

Registered in Florida?

Check your voter registration with the [Florida Department of State](#) to make sure you can vote. You should also check to make sure your address is correct, especially if you've moved in the past few years.

What's on my Ballot?

If you want to prepare ahead of time, visit the [county Supervisor of Elections website](#) to download a sample ballot for your address.



Not Registered in Florida?

If you're not from Florida and you'd like to vote in your home state or you'd like to vote by mail, visit the [Absentee Voting page on USA.gov](#) to learn how you can do so.

If you aren't currently registered as a Florida resident but would like to vote here, visit the [Florida Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles page](#) to find out how you can get a Florida ID.

If you do have a Florida ID, but aren't registered to vote or need to update your information, head to [this page run by the Florida Department of State](#) to do so. You'll need the following:

- a Florida ID or driver's license,
- the issued date of that ID/license, and
- the last four digits of your Social Security number.

Alachua County offers early voting beginning on October 21st. Unlike on Election Day, anyone can vote at any of these locations from 9 am to 6 pm, through November 3.
